Overview

Welcome to the Vertex Certified training program! During this program, you will have access to a curriculum of courseware designed to teach you everything you need to know about Vertex Indirect Tax O Series 7.x for sales tax in North America. The courseware includes both a series of self-paced e-learning modules as well as scheduled virtual classes. Additionally, you will be given the opportunity to validate what you have learned via the knowledge and performance examinations.

Program Enhancements for 7.x

Based on feedback and to align with certification program best practices, many enhancements were made for 7.x. These include:

- ***A single, comprehensive curriculum***
Prior versions of this certification offered separate curriculum tracks. Based on candidate feedback, we streamlined the 7.x certification. This resulted in a single, comprehensive curriculum that is more applicable to a wider variety of job roles. To accommodate this, some courses that are very role-specific are now optional. Since this is a functional user certification, these optional courses are the technical courses that are not typically expected of those in a functional tax role.

Prerequisites

The following prerequisites apply to *both* the Foundation and Advanced certification tracks.

To complete the Vertex Certified training program, you should have:

- Working knowledge of sales and use tax concepts; real-world experience in a related role is recommended, but not required (see Intended Audience below)
- Familiarity with your company's tax reporting requirements
- Experience with Windows-based navigation
- Experience with learning in an online format and comfort with working in a self-directed manner(recommended)

Intended Audience

The intended audience for this certification includes Tax or IT professionals who need to demonstrate thorough knowledge of and competency with using Vertex O Series as part of their job function. Participants should ideally have one to two years' prior sales and use tax compliance industry experience and a working knowledge of sales and use tax concepts prior to beginning the program.


Technical Requirements


Steps to Become Certified

To become a certified, you must register as a candidate for the certification, complete the required course curriculum, pass a performance examination, and pass the knowledge examination.



Previously Certified?

We offer an accelerated path for upgrade candidates to certify on the current version. Upgrade candidates can achieve 7.x certification by completing the following requirements. Note that the complete learning curriculum is available to you to prepare for the exam, but completing it is not required.



Steps to Certification for those Currently Certified on O Series 6.x

1. Register as an upgrade candidate.
2. Complete the required course, “Vertex Indirect Tax O Series 7.x: North American Sales Tax Enhancements” to learn what’s new for version 7.x.
3. Pass the Knowledge Examination.

Recommended Completion Time for Vertex Certification

We generally recommend that learners complete each certification track within six months to one year of enrollment date. We have found that learners who complete the program within this time frame tend to stick with the program and get the most out of it.
