Changing Sales & Use Tax Legislation

Before South Dakota v. Wayfair there was Quill

- Law of the Land, decided in 1992
- Nexus defined: a business must have a "physical presence" in a state to collect sales tax
- Many states challenged Quill
- South Dakota was most aggressive

Changing Legislation: South Dakota v. Wayfair (6/2018)

- This ruling overturned Quill
- Expanded the definition of nexus to include economic presence as a determining factor in which businesses are liable to collect & remit sales & use tax

What's Changed?

Jurisdictions enforcing new economic nexus guidelines

- As of April 2019, a total of 46 states have made changes to their economic nexus thresholds
 - Economic thresholds are defined by total gross revenue and/or number of transactions, with each jurisdiction having unique thresholds
 - With the ability to collect from online transactions jurisdictions are estimated to collect an estimated \$8-\$23 billion in new taxes across the US

Jurisdictions hiring more auditors

- Wisconsin Department of Revenue hired 102 new auditors and increased their division by one-third, generating an estimate of \$88 million in additional revenue
- California has added 100 new auditors and will generate an estimate of \$371 million in additional revenue each year

What Does This Mean For Your Business?

Small to mid-size businesses are at a higher risk of audit

Noncompliance: Audit Exposure

- The average audit can last anywhere from 30-45 days, with an auditor onsite anywhere between 2-4 weeks
- Average cost of an audit (penalties, interest, fees) \$114,000, not including lost productivity

Complexity

- As a business, are you aware of?
 - 11,000 unique jurisdictions
 - More than 60,000 unique taxability rates & rules
 - On average more than 600 rate & rule changes each year
