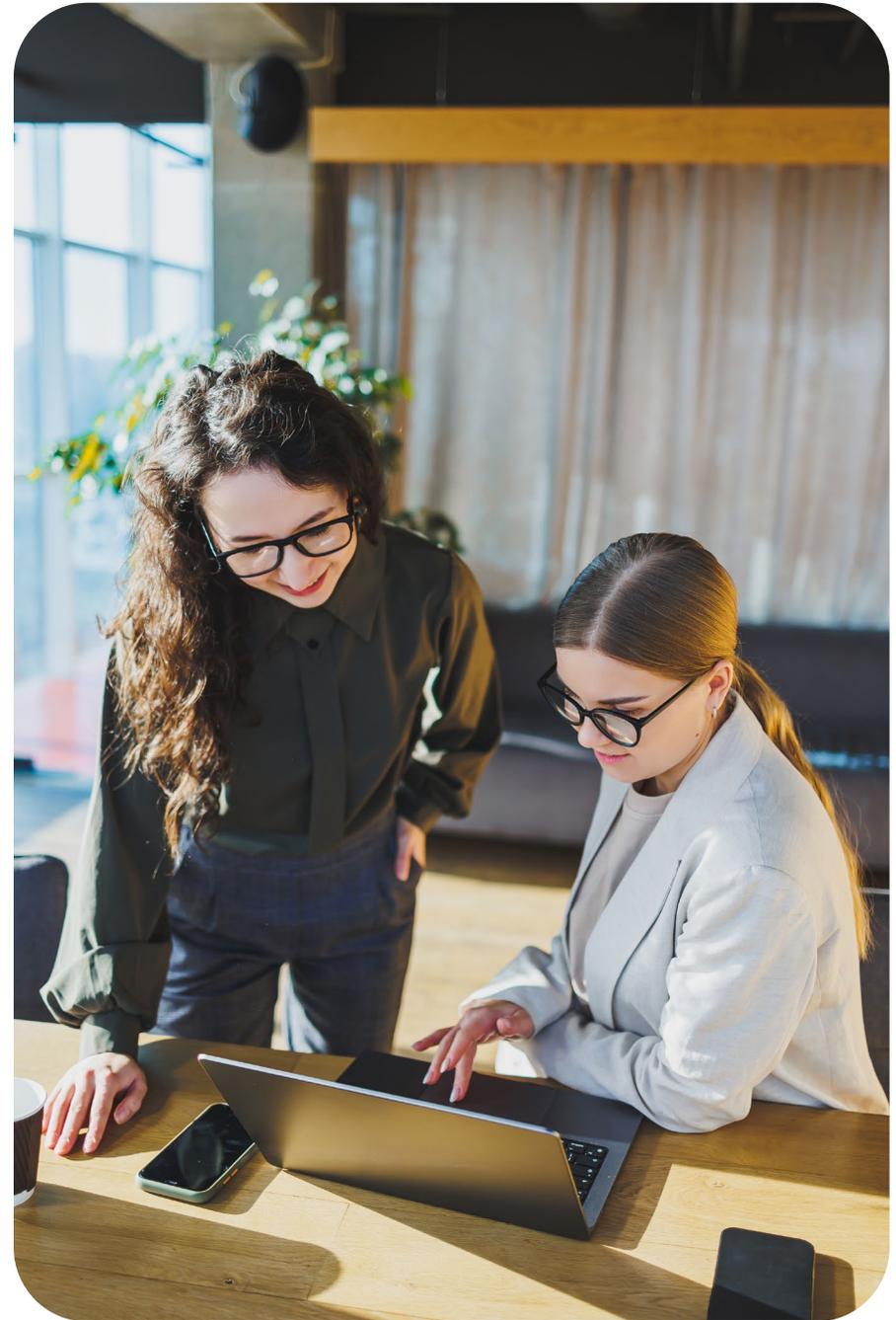

Key compliance findings from our research

Our research revealed four key barriers that businesses face in maintaining sales tax compliance:

- Data quality
- Technology
- Staff skills
- Regulatory change

The right technology solves these barriers

The best way to address these sales tax compliance barriers— data quality, technology, staff skills, and pace of regulatory change— is the end-to-end, automated, integrated, cloud-based sales tax solution.

Here's why and how...



Barrier #1: Data quality

The accuracy of tax data emerged as the most significant barrier, with 41% of respondents identifying it as a gap. Data issues could be caused by master data errors, inaccurate tax calculation caused by a variety of factors, or manual data movement when generating returns. This lack of precision often results in inaccurate tax compliance and increases audit risk.

Solution

Monthly compliance actually starts at the tax calculation step. The familiar expression “garbage in, garbage out” is most relevant here. An automated tax engine significantly enhances compliance data quality by improving tax calculation precision. The combination of robust tax content and tax exemption logic yields a more precise tax amount. Then a platform that integrates calculation and returns automatically feeds the transactional tax data and populates it into the return forms. This automation reduces the risk of errors from selecting the wrong form or manual data entry, ensuring greater accuracy across the process. Additionally, some tax engines incorporate address cleansing for more precise jurisdiction identification, which further enhances tax calculation accuracy and the reliability of return forms. These features collectively result in higher-quality, more reliable compliance data.

- The **Vertex tax engine** features robust tax content for even the most complex tax scenarios. Built-in U.S. address **cleansing** and exemption logic adds precision.

Barrier #2: Technology

Nearly 40% of survey respondents reported that inadequate technology was a major obstacle. From missing integrations to outdated tools, technology gaps create inefficiencies and increase risks. However, 74% agreed that having the right technology is critical to achieving effective compliance.

Solution

And a single tax engine can integrate to multiple source systems— such as ERP, e-commerce, and other financial platforms—to support company-wide tax determination in a centralized manner. The added benefit of cloud deployment means the provider handles the content and maintenance, eliminating the need for IT infrastructure and updates. This streamlines operations, reduces IT workload, and helps to ensure seamless, up-to-date functionality.

Barrier #3: Staff skills

Another 39% of respondents pointed to staff skills as a key barrier, with 36% identifying skill gaps as the largest compliance challenge. While tax-specific expertise remains essential, there's growing demand for technology specialists to complement tax professionals.

Solution

Implementing a tax engine with continually updated content and robust calculation logic reduces the need for time-consuming tax research and specialized tax expertise. Automating tax calculation and returns generation significantly reduces manual steps and simplify the compliance process for tax teams. And an intuitive user interface, single sign-on, and consistent workflows can minimize training needs and accelerate mastery of the solution. In addition to accelerated onboarding and training, the right tax technology solution streamlines the compliance process to allow time for staff to focus on more strategic work. This is especially valuable for companies facing staffing shortages, as it maximizes productivity and efficiency.
